

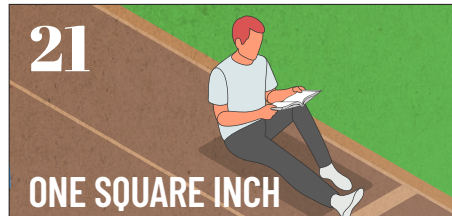


ANSLEY JANE BEEDY
